The President has bragged that military spending will actually increase in the coming years. Even the "cuts" that have been projected are cuts from projected increases, not from a current baseline.

Now, members of Congress want to repeal the additional military cuts mandated by last summer's budget compromise. Senator Jon Kyl has introduced the "Down Payment to Protect National Security Act of 2012," which stops the mandatory cuts to the defense budget.
